GUIDELINES

OUR Credit Union will grant **three** \$1000 Scholarships to individuals who are part of the graduating Class of 2023. Those who meet the following criteria may apply:

1. Applicant must be a member of OUR Credit Union.*
2. Applicant must be pursuing their education at an accredited institution, trade school, vocational school, community college or university.
3. Applicant must be accepted by the school and plan to be enrolled, at minimum, as a part-time student (6 credit hours).
4. Applicants who have been awarded an OUR Credit Union Scholarship in the past may not apply.

Please include the following items with your completed application:

- One recent letter of recommendation
- Two non-family references (Listed on Application - Name, Phone and Email)
- 500 Word Essay - see below for details and topic
- List of Community Involvement and School Related Involvement

ONE LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

The written recommendations can be from a past or present employer, coach, teacher, instructor, counselor, community leader, etc., but must be written by an unrelated adult. The letter should be recent, signed and address why the applicant deserves the scholarship as well as elaborate the applicant's character and accomplishments.

ESSAY

Selection criteria will include: ideas/content, organization, sentence fluency, and grammar. The essay should be approximately 500 words, typed in 12 pt font.

Essay Topic: Describe a solution you would propose to resolve a current societal issue that you feel strongly about.

*All applications must be submitted to an OUR Credit Union Branch or via email: acallahan@ourcuonline.org by Saturday, **March 11, 2023** at 1 pm (the close of business). Late applications will not be accepted. Incomplete applications will not be considered.*

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***Applicants may not use a guardian's member number.**

The scholarship recipient will be notified by May 5, 2023. This scholarship is available for tuition, books and fees. At OUR Credit Union's discretion, the scholarship will be paid directly to the educational institution the student is attending, the scholarship recipient, or recipient's guardian. The awards will be paid upon receiving a bill or paid receipt.
